Part of frontage to be exposed stone masonry where previously buried into hillside. OBJECT on the grounds this is over development of the site and appears to be designed as a separate dwelling, directly onto the unadopted lane. The 'boat store' would also be in front of the build line and would alter the street scene. It would also be clearly visible from SW Coast Path. This application is pushing the boundaries of acceptable development and Members are very concerned about the visibility from the SW Coast Path.	Clerk	
	j.	Trewiston Development – Cllrs. Mould and Gisbourne had met with Mr Mark Evans, case officer, to inspect the new plans, which amount to 44 units in total with 22 affordable properties. The site is identified in the Neighbourhood Plan as being suitable for development.		
		At today's meeting, the developers had been asked to consider [1] the public open space contribution to go to the Hub, [2] the open market housing to have a permanent residency clause, [3] absolutely no "build out" onto Rock Road, [4] there must be a provision of a safe footway, and [5] the 30mph speed zone to be extended to include the site.		
		In principle Members are happy to look at this proposal, but felt there were still too many units, they wish to see a number closer to thirty.	Clerk
